SUBJECT: Customs and Excise Duty Exemption.

It is hereby informed to all the concerned that our earlier letter (No.PU/Dev/1062 dated 19.12.2003) on the subject mentioned above be treated as cancelled.

As per the policy decision taken by the University Authorities, the procedure for "Issue of Essentiality Certificate" for claiming Customs and Excise Duty Exemption has been revised. Henceforth the following procedure shall be adopted by the Affiliated Colleges and Recognized Institutes for obtaining the Essentiality Certificate for claiming Customs Duty Exemption / Central Excise Duty Exemption.

- The College/Institute shall prepare four (04) copies of the Essentiality Certificate in original and submit it to the Planning and Development Branch of the University of Pune.
- The College shall submit the following documents in original + 3 xerox copies:
 - a) Affiliation letter issued to the College/Institute.
 - b) Sanction letter of the Research Project.
 - c) Syllabus of the Course for which equipment is to be purchased so as to justify whether the research work is included in the syllabus.
 - d) Purchase Order of the equipment
 - e) AICTE approval, if applicable.
 - f) Letter of Recognition as Research Centre, if applicable.
- In this connection, the following documents are enclosed.
- 1) Proforma of application for Essentiality Certificate for claiming Customs Duty Exemption on equipment/spare parts/accessories / consumables, prototypes imported for research purposes in terms of Government notification No. 51/9-Customs dated 23rd July, 1996 as amended from time to time.
- 2) Proforma of application for Essentiality Certificate for claiming Central Excise Duty Exemption on equipment / spare parts / accessories / consumables, prototypes imported for research purposes in terms of Government notification No. 10/9-Central Excise dated 1st of March, 1997 as amended from time to time.
- 3) Format of Affidavit to be filled and submitted by the Principal/Director of the Affiliated Colleges/Recognised Institutes. (Affidavit should be made on Rs. 100/- Stamp paper and duly notarized).

It is requested to kindly bring the contents of this Circular to all concerned so as to ensure the effective implementation of the procedure and do the needful in this regard.
