UNDERTAKING BY THE STUDENT APPLYING FOR ELICIS

Rules & Regulations to be followed by ELICIS students are:

- 1. Students will have to abide by a strict code of conduct. Severe action will be taken against those who do not.
- 2. The University may change, suspend and/or amend any of these rules any time without any notice. Students will be deemed to have read these rules and deemed to have agreed to be bound by them and all changes may be made therein, from time to time.
- 3. Students must attend class regularly. 70% attendance will be compulsory for all. Students whose attendance falls short will not be allowed to sit for the exam and will not receive the certificate.
- 4. Indiscipline and bad behavior in class will not be tolerated. Students will have to respect and obey the teachers.
- 5. All students shall be responsible for the classroom property and will have to re-imburse the University for any damage or loss.
- 6. Only English has to be spoken in class. Conversation amongst students in their mother tongue will not be allowed.
- 7. It is compulsory for the students to bring a dictionary to class every day. They must carry both the bi-lingual and English dictionary.
- 8. The prescribed syllabus shall be followed strictly. No argument or dissent regarding this would be allowed. If the students have any problems they must speak to the Coordinator.
- 9. During class, students must sit in the classroom. They cannot walk outside the classroom, in the corridor or even to go to the office. All the office work should be done in the break or after the class.
- 10. Class timings, shall be strictly followed. Students cannot walk into class any time. Students will be marked absent if they come late or if they come only for one class.
- 11. All Cell phones should be switched off before you enter the class.
- 12. Students are advised not to leave valuable articles, cell phones, books etc. in the classroom. If they do so it will be entirely at their own risk.
- 13. Students should not come to the class with chewing gum, sweets or any other eatables.
- 14. There will be no partying or celebration during class. It should be done in the canteen or outside the campus.
- 15. Students who obtain B+ (61%) and more shall be exempted from giving the English Proficiency Test (EPT), which is otherwise compulsory for all students taking admission in the University.
- 16. All students who have got 'B' grade or have failed must take the English Proficiency Test in their first year at the University.
- 17. There will be no revaluation of answer papers under any circumstances.
- 18. In all matters concerning the ELICIS, the decision of the University Authorities or their representatives shall be final.
