Five Year Integrated M. A./ M.Sc. Course in Defence, Strategic and National Security Studies

Features of the course:

The Five-year Integrated M.A. / M.Sc. programme is open to students who have completed Higher Secondary School Certificate or HSC (10+2/ its equivalent examination in Arts / Commerce / Science stream, from any recognized board in India.) from any stream. The course will provide foundational knowledge in the core concepts of the discipline of national and global security. The course will focus on India's National Security, Global Security, Defence Economics, Geopolitics and Military Geography, Indian Military System, Indian Strategic Culture, International Relations, UN System, Global

Peace and Security, Terrorism and Counter Terrorism, CBRN along with Ability and Skill Enhancement Courses, Discipline elective courses and Generic elective courses including foreign languages and compulsory English.

Scope of the course:

- Inculcate a holistic and interdisciplinary orientation towards national security.
- Provide multidisciplinary foundation for an overall perspective on India's national security, defence and strategic studies.

Objectives of the course:

- Train students to become reflective and critical thinkers.
- Equip students in interdisciplinary skills.
- Provide additional perspectives to comprehend issues based on global security environment.
- Mould students to be leaders.
- Develop independent thinking amongst students.
- Develop analytical skills and their application to national and global security issues.
- Provide multidisciplinary foundational knowledge in the core concepts of the discipline of national and global security.

Structure of the Course:

[The Five Year Integrated Course offers an exit option after three years; in that case students will be awarded Bachelors Degree in Arts (B.A.) / Science (B.Sc.).]

- Students completing a two year post graduate course will be awarded the Degree of Masters in M.A./M.Sc.
- The Course is divided in three levels - Discipline Specific Core Paper; Choice Based Credit Electives and Skills Enhancing Papers.
- The course also has two Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses, two Ability Enhancement Elective Courses (skill based), four General Elective Courses and four Discipline Specific Elective Courses and Dissertation as per the UGC guidelines.

Course Description and Evaluation:

- The Five Year Integrated course consists of ten semesters. However, the course offers an exit option after three years in which case students will be awarded Bachelors Degree as per their stream.
- Medium of instruction is English (Students would however, be permitted to write their examination in Marathi, as an option).
- Classroom Lectures (50%).

- Assignments, projects and internships (50%).
- Two Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) Papers of 100 marks each in which 50 marks are for theory and 50 marks are for internal assessment.
- Two AECC Papers of 100 marks each in which 50 marks are for theory and 50 marks are for internal assessment.
- Four General Elective (GE) Papers of 100 marks each in which 50 marks are for theory and 50 marks are for internal assessment.
- Four Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) papers of 100 marks each in which 50 marks are for theory and 50 marks are for internal assessment.
- Compulsory Language Papers in all ten semesters also follow the same pattern, i.e. 50 marks for theory and 50 marks for internal assessment.

Method of Teaching:

- Utilize a variety of instructional methods- classroom interactions, tutorials, debates, field visits, the open book method, round table discussion panels, online learning, problem-based learning, comparative studies, oral presentations, text analysis, problem solving, library work and discussions.
- Special lectures by eminent scholars.
- Conduct seminars, webinars and discussion panels.

- The course will be beneficial to students and professionals. It will help individuals in pursuing their academic and career goals.
- Prepare for strong foundation for teaching and research opportunities.
- Prepare for employment in government and corporate sectors as policy advisors.
