Features and Scope of the course:

The Post Graduate Diploma in European Peace and Security is designed to cover the historical, cultural and economic development of Europe from the Roman Empire to the European Union. Europe can be considered the cradle of modern-day democratic states and values. The European Union was the first to have the idea of "making war unthinkable and materially impossible". Europeans have a long history of resolving conflict through peaceful means. The UN provision about pacific settlement is the product of that long tradition.

Structure of the Course:

- The course has 32 credits, divided into two semesters, over one year.
- The course will focus on major thrust areas like, European Peace and Security, the European Approach to the Contemporary World, the European Union: Comparative Studies and European Peace and Security etc.

Course Description and Evaluation:

- Post Graduate Diploma in European Peace and Security (EUPS) is a full-time program.
- Medium of instruction is English (Students would however, be permitted to write their examination in Marathi, as an option).
- For assessment, the department will follow the choice-based credit system (CBCS).
- Continuous evaluation system through internal assessment (50%) assignments, dissertation, term papers and seminars.
- External assessment -end semester examination (50%).
