

The Department of Botany, University of Pune welcomes you with immense pleasure to the three days International Conference and one day workshop. These will be held from 10th to 13th January 2012. It is expected to serve as a platform for effective interaction between academicians, researchers, students, pharmaceutical industrialists, medicinal plant growers, for meaningful discussions on issues related to medicinal plants. We hope that the conference and workwhop will come up with concrete, suggestions, recommendations and action plans for cultivation, conservation and sustainable utilization of medicinal plants for enhanced production of therapeutically active secondary metabolites.

Background

The conference therefore is expected to give leads or clues for further research and also indicate the future plans of action for sustainable utilization of medicinal plants for welfare of all living beings around.

Research work published or presented elsewhere will not be accepted. The abstract should be typed in Times New Roman (font 12 with 1.5 spacing on A4 paper size (Margins Top 0.5, Bottom 0.5, Right 0.5, and Left 0.5). The maximum word limit is 250 words for each abstract. Name of presenting author and corresponding author must be specified clearly.
