## ✤ Guidelines for submitting Abstract :

The title and abstract of paper in soft copy (Max. 250 words only) will have to be submitted on or before 22<sup>th</sup> February 2014. After a peer review full paper (upto 5000 words only) will be published as proceedings after the workshop. The abstracts selected for presentation will be informed by 28<sup>st</sup> February 2014. Interested Faculty members can submit their abstracts at <u>hreworkshop2014@gmail.com</u>. The theme of abstracts must be submitted with an undertaking that it is original and unpublished paper.

## Format of Abstract and Paper:

- Soft copy (A4 Size)
- MSWord (2000-2007)
- Font: Times New Roman; Size: 12 for Text, 10 for Footnotes.
- Line Spacing: 1.5 for Text, Single for Footnotes
- Word limit (including footnotes and bibliography): 250 for abstract, upto 5000 for Full Paper.

#### II) Poster Presentations :

Students of the Departments of the University of Pune alone are invited either individually or in a group (not exceeding maximum three participants) to present posters during the workshop.
