Only 2 prizes (lst and llnd) will be awarded if the entries in any language and category are less than 20.

If the entries in any language and category are less than 10, the decision of the Judges will be final and binding.

The Rules of the competition are as follows:

- The competition is open to Junior college students of Higher Secondary Schools recognised by S.S.C. and H.S.C Boards of Maharashtra and Senior College Students of colleges affiliated to the Universities in Maharashtra.
- Each college can send in <u>only two entries</u> in each language and each category for this competition. If more entries are sent the institute will be disqualified.
- 3. Entries can be in English, Marathi, Hindi or Gujarati.
- 4. The essay should not be more than 2500 words.
- 5. A student can participate in only one language.
- 6. The entries can either be hand written or typed on one side of a plain paper.
- 7. The participant student should mention clearly at the top of his Essay his Name, Residential Address, Tel No. (if any) and Name of the College & year of his study.
- 8. Entries along with **bonafide certificate** from the college authorities should reach us at the above address **before** 20/10/2012
- 9. The result is expected to be declared by the end of December 2012
- The decision of the Judges will be final and binding.
