## *State level “Harit Urja Dindi” from Pune to Pandharpur. (2004 to 2012)*

“Harit Urja Dindi” is being conducted by The National Service Scheme, University of Pune, since 2004. Nearly 250 NSS volunteers from all Universities in the state participate in this procession.

In this procession & 10 to 12 Lac Varkari Participate in awareness and motivational lectures are arranged by NSS Program Officers & Volunteers along the route of 250 KM from Pune to Pandharpur on the topics such as : Tree plantation, seed sowing, female feticide, literacy, hygiene, Information regarding agriculture etc. Accordingly, 20 lakh seeds of various types and 2 lakh trees have been planted during the last 7 years. (Environmental and medicinal species) Social awareness has been created through street shows, speeches and Rallies. The camping area was cleaned by sprinkling disinfectants.





## *Anti drug Campaign & Voting Awareness Campaign*

The Dept. of N.S.S. implemented and carried out this campaign in all the colleges and displayed banners and posters highlighting the bad effects of smoking and consumption of tobacco products including ghutka.

More than a thousand students participated in these programs on "Right & Duty to Vote", "Value of Vote" arranged in Pune City by the Dept. of N.S.S. to make the society aware of the issue of voting.





## *Anandvan - Personality Development, Shramsamskar at Somnath Camp, Gadchiroli*

From the year 2005 a scheme is being implemented for the visit of NSS volunteers to Anandvan of Hon'ble late Baba Amte followed by "Personality Development Workmanship-culture Campaign". More than 250 volunteers from Pune, Nagar and Nasik district take part in this program. These students visit the leprosy ashram. This affects the minds of the youth in a positive and constructive manner, especially by the self reliance of the leprosy patients. During the labour and workmanship campaign construction of barrages and other sanitation programs are carried out. Self supported livelihood of these blind, handicapped and leprosy patients develop a new vision among the NSS volunteers.



The duration of the program is 10 days.

## *Adopted villages by NSS*

There are 310 NSS based colleges in Pune Nagar and Nasik district under University of Pune. Each college has adopted one village and arranged special camp successfully. 299 Colleges have adopted such villages and implemented the program of cleaning rivers, nalas, drainage, gutters etc. Regular surveys are conducted for generating data base. A project report of every village has been prepared in accordance with 'New Trends of NSS. Awareness and action of the village community are generated through lectures and motivational programs on topics like: female feticide prevention, blood donation, literacy, family planning, dowry prevention, cleanliness, environmental protection, tree plantation, information about agriculture etc. Solar lights have been installed, Computer training given to the students, Streets are constructed by colleges. Barrages were constructed in the village to overcome water scarcity in the villages. More than 7 lakh trees and seeds were planted and all the colleges took the responsibility of plantation survival. Latrines and cocas pits were constructed by the volunteers under Individual and Community Sanitation programs. Large number of plantation has been carried out with the principle of 'One student one tree' in rural areas.





## *Kanya Ratna Abhiyan*

The University of Pune decided to implement "Save Girl Child" expedition as per the suggestion of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Pune University. Accordingly, "Save Girl ", "Kanyaratna Expedition" is being implemented in the NSS Colleges from 2012-13.

More than 12000 NSS volunteers participated in the rally on "Female Feticide Prevention" in all the NSS based colleges in Pune, Ahmadnagar and Nasik Districts.

Lectures were arranged in various colleges on "Kanyaratna Expedition". 25000 students in various colleges participated in it. Street Show Groups were established for raising awareness on "Female Feticide Prevention".





## *Blood donation Campaign:*

The Department of NSS, University of Pune organizes regular and special Blood Donation camps in all the colleges. Hemoglobin check up is also carried out. Special blood donation camps are arranged at the time of disasters, accidents, floods, bomb blast etc. and Special 1 week festival is arranged from 2nd October - Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti every year. The NSS volunteers contribute their enthusiastic participation in this program and donate blood. These blood bottles are collected and donated in the nearby hospitals.

The Blood donation help line has started on NSS Website and the list of blood donor students and volunteers of Pune, Nagar and Nasik colleges along with their blood group and contact numbers have been uploaded on this website.

During the years 2010 to 2012, more than 700 such blood donation





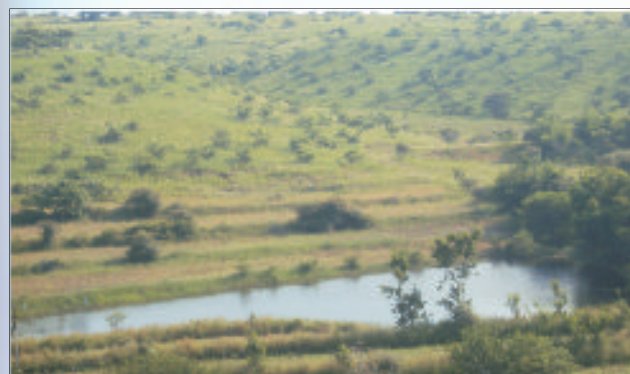
## *Tree plantation Expedition*

Tree plantation and seed plantation is given prime emphasis during the regular and special camps by 45000 volunteers in 329 colleges of Pune, Nagar and Nasik districts under the University of Pune. Responsibility of plant protection and survival is entrusted with the students of respective colleges.

Plantation of 10 lakh trees and more than 20 lakh seeds have taken place during 2010 to 2013 by 329 colleges in the above three districts.

Similarly, some colleges took up plantation of environmental and medicinal species. It has been planned to implement the program of "One tree for one student" by NSS for maximizing tree plantation in every coming year. Special plantation programs were launched on the occasion of World Environment Day every year.

More than 40000 students took part in "Save Trees and Save Earth" Program.





## *Hemoglobin Check-up*

The NSS conducted Blood Check Up of 2000 girl students in the Colleges in the Pune District during the year 2009-10. This revealed shocking facts. It was found that 85% girl students were having hemoglobin level of 7-8% only. Hence, priority was given to Hemoglobin Check Up in all the colleges. Suitable treatment and consultation was provided to the needy girl students by the doctors. Instructions about diet were given to the youngsters by displaying posters in the colleges.

Accordingly, under regular and special camps, the lectures of specialist doctors are arranged for educating 45000 NSS volunteers. Pune Municipal Corporation distributed Free Health Cards to the girl students in 150 colleges. Health check up was conducted and report entered on the Health Cards. In this manner Hemoglobin check up program is being implemented by NSS girl volunteers in Pune, Nagar and Nasik districts.





## *Water Shed Management/CCT/Barrages*

Water Shed/CCT/ barrages etc. were constructed/ implemented against the background of scarcity in college campus and villages by the NSS volunteers. Continuous contour trenching was carried out in large number of scarcity affected villages of Pune, Nagar and Nasik district. These measures have been found effective for raising the ground water level. The NSS volunteers were given technical training of CCT.

Similarly, The Vasundhara Group of Pune gave training to the volunteers of NSS and implemented the CCT program on the hills surrounding Pune City. Trees were planted along with CCT. Nearly 700 students took part in this 7 day expedition.





## Red Ribbon club : Aids Awareness

Red Ribbon Clubs have been established in 70 colleges of Pune, Nagar and Nasik districts. These clubs carry out health-related activities such as Aids awareness, blood check-up, health check-up, health related problems of the students, blood donation camps

## *Writer Club under N S S for blind Students & Pulse Polio Campaign*

Writer Club was installed under N S S, Pune University for the blind students who are taking higher education to write answer papers in the examinations for them. Students of Writer Club in Ness Wadia College help blind students in the college to write their papers.

Pulse Polio Campaign was organized in the State by the Health Department between 22 and 24 February 2013. The N S S college students went to the various places of Polio Booth, Primary Health Centres, District Civil Hospitals, District Primary Schools in the vicinity of the colleges and helped the drive and created awareness about it in the society.





## *History Writing of Villages*

History writing workshops have been arranged in these adopted 299 villages through NSS for generating awareness about History writing. From the year 2007, history writing on the topic "adopted villages" has been started by College professors. Total 4 volumes have been published till 2012, and the history writing of 160 villages have been completed.

History writing of a village includes: history of the village, rural traditions, style of livelihood, Tahasil office, dispensaries, Government hospitals, govt. schools (probably Primary & High schools), temples, caste system, literate-illiterate ratio, water arrangements, population bifurcation etc. This history writing done by the NSS can help education management of the village.

The History writing of total 160 villages has been completed in four volumes. History writing of 100 villages is in process. Thus 300 NSS professors of 300 colleges are doing this work of History writing. One extra-ordinary program have been conducted by NSS, University of Pune.

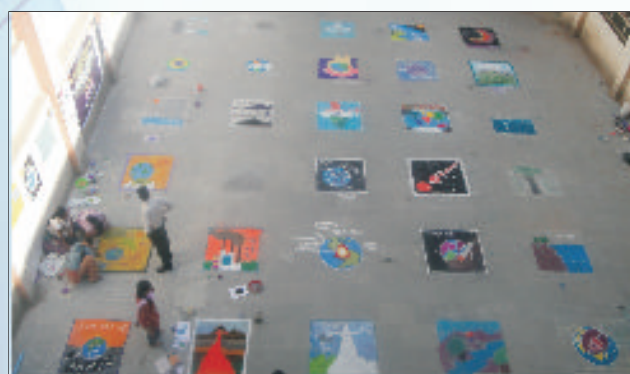




## *NSS Open Unit & Post Graduation Unit*

Open unit program has been started since the year 2008 for those having special interest in social work and 200 youth are granted membership in the same. This includes ex volunteers, Presidents of various social organizations and women representatives of the N.S.S. Dept. in the University of Pune. With the help of these members various social programs such as Female fetus' awareness, Environmental Awareness, Pollution Control, Literacy, Computer Literacy, Tree-plantation, Save Energy, Career Guidance and related workshops, seminars, rallies etc. were organized. In these programs the open unit members are given training on the related topics and they further passed on the same to the students in the colleges.

The Dept. of N.S.S. has established a special P.G. unit of 150 students of post graduation in the University of Pune. It organizes special camps for them in nearby adopted villages. Similarly, workshops on the topics of career guidance, tree-plantation and Literacy are arranged throughout the year.

The sarpanch of the village Utrane, Mr. Govinda Garud expressed thankfulness of our college. To considering these all facts, our college in awarded the best college for implementation of tree plantation programme successfully by the hands of director, Dr. V. B. Gaidwad Director, BCUD, University of Pune, to conclude, we have proud to say that our rural college achievements are really praiseworthy for us.





*Water Conservation through SHRAMDAN by NSS Volunteer  
MVP's Shantarambapu Wavre College, CIDCO, Nashik*

Seven Year of Perseverance and determination shown by Prof. Tukaram Ghule and Villagers from Girnare has paid rich dividends. Their efforts revived four abandoned wells in the Girnare Village bringing back water so them.

Prof. S. T. Ghule, Program Officer, of trhis college and a teacher of Mathematic at MVPs Shantarambapu Wavre College in CIDCO, Nashik, is native of Girnare Village which is surrounded by dams on three sides. There are four wells in the village built during the peshwas.

To provide water for local villagers. They are situated in four directions with the khokad well in the north. Aad Well in the East. Zira Well in the South and Ahilya Bai Holkar Barav in the west. The Ahilyabai Holkar Barav is said to rebuilt during the region of Queen Ahilyabai Holkar which is on the oldest well in the district. Currently villagers use the water from this well for domestic use.





## *Change In Village Through National Service Scheme Gramonnati Mandal's Arts, Commerce & Science College Narayangaon, Taluka Junnar, Dist. Pune*

University of Pune and the N.S.S. unit of Gramonnati Mandal's Arts, Commerce and Science College, Narayangaon has adopted the village Khodad from the academic year 2011-2012. With the help of the villagers, volunteers and students of Khodad, self-help groups of women were formed for the empowerment of women. The self-help groups of women were apprised of various schemes of the government. For the benefit of senior citizens awareness camps and grama sabhas were arranged. To make the villagers conscious about various health factors, AIDS campaign, Hagandarimukt village campaign were undertaken. The students of N.S.S. took out morning processions and performed street plays. For the health awareness among the villagers, free health checkup camps were arranged with the help of doctors and the villagers were given free medicines. During the camp the villagers were made conscious about issues of environment, moral values, prevention of female feticide, and forest and fort conservation mainly through speeches by invited expert speakers.

With the help of the volunteers of N.S.S. of our college campaigns such as Save Water, Conserve Water, Forest Conservation, Village Cleanliness, Road Development and Repairing were undertaken. N.S.S. contributed towards conserving water by building 5 dams each of 20 feet length and 6 feet depth and were made of cement and soil. The volunteers of N.S.S. made a road of 1k.m. in dalit colony of the village. Through the campaign of cleanliness, gutters and roads in the village were cleaned. Handbills were distributed during rallies and the villagers were told to prevent female feticide. To make people aware of the historical importance of Narayangad at Khodad, our teachers wrote and published a book with the title 'Aitihasik Durg Narayangad'. To enable the villagers climb up the fort easily, the N.S.S. volunteers repaired the steps and the road leading to the top of Narayangad. The water tanks in the fort atop the gad were cleaned.

Narayangad was awarded 'C' grade due to the joint efforts of the villagers, N.S.S. volunteers and the Forest Department. The total value of the work, programs, and expenses incurred during the last two years is estimated at Rs. 12 lakhs. The Forest Department is further willing to provide for forest conservation, tree plantation and water supply for the development of Narayangad. The villagers have been overwhelmed by the spirit of Narayangaon College N.S.S. volunteers, leading to future plans for the development of the village by Grampanchayat, Forest Dept. and Government.
