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## Regular Activities (Report) :



In the academic year 2008-09 as per the university recognition, 250 students were enrolled in NSS. The students cleaned the college ground and the campus of the Bhagatsingh stadium under Shramdan. Students were guided on the current topics like 'Financial literacy'

and 'personality development and NSS'. A variety of newer initiatives like elocution competition were implemented on every Sundays and on different occasions.

Some of the notable initiatives were as follows-

- 1) A Training programme was organized for the Volunteers on 17<sup>th</sup> Aug.08.
- 2) Nearly 150 plants were planted in the adopted village Warude on 20 Aug.08.
- 3) On 23<sup>rd</sup> Aug., on the occasion of the birth centenary of Hutatma Rajguru, a torch marathon was organized from the birth place of rajguru to the college campus. A chariot rally was organized on 24<sup>th</sup> Aug.08.

- 4) A Relief fund of Rs. 10645/- lacs collected for the flood affected victims of Bihar on 27<sup>th</sup> Sep 2008. and the fund was forwarded to the N.S.S Dept of the University of Pune.
  - 5) A rally was organized for 'AIDS' in collaboration with the civil hospital, Chandoli , Rajgurunagar on 1<sup>st</sup> Dec 2008.
  - 6) A blood donation camp was organized on 3<sup>rd</sup> Jan 2009, in commemoration of the founder president, late. Shri Sahebraoji Butte Patil. 69 blood donators participated in this camp and it was organized in collaboration with the Sasson Hospital Blood Bank.
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- 7) Volunteers of the college actively participated in the various activities organized by the University, for example
    - 1) Anandwan camp
    - 2) Republic Day parade camp
    - 3) Energy Literacy camp(Manchar)
    - 4) Adventure Camp (Himachal Pradesh)

In short, very useful activities and programmes were implemented for the personality development of the Volunteers and their communication towards the society.

### **Special Camp (Report)-**



The college participated in two camps in the year 2008-09.

- A) 40 volunteers participated in the camp organized at Warude from 23<sup>rd</sup> Sep 2008 to 2<sup>nd</sup> Oct 2008. By the Govt. of Maharashtra. 38 toilets were built during the period of this camp. Rallies were undertaken every day for the awareness of the villagers.

**B. The Winter camp of the college was organized at Warude from 1/12/08 to 10/12/08.**

**150 volunteers participated in the camp. Different activities were undertaken right from 5.30 am. To 11.00 pm.**

- 2. Nearly 80 pits were tilled for toilet and many toilet constructions were also completed in the same period.**
- 3. The road to Khandoba Mal was completed.**
- 4. People of the Warude were convinced for building toilets for home.**
- 5. Lectured were organized for the volunteers and the villagers in the evening session.**
- 6. Formar P.O. of N.S.S expressed their views and opinions on the topic 'N.S.S and We' for the benifit of the volunteers.**
