National Service Scheme:

Higher and technical Education Maharashtra state has sanctioned 32,813 volunteers strength to Pune University for the year 2003-2004. Which has been distributed in 184 colleges situated in Pune, Ahmednagar and Nashik district.

NSS activities have been divided in two major groups. These are regular activities and special camping programme.

The units in Colleges were allotted as 50, 100,150,200 & 250.
