Annual Report 2004-2005

National Service Scheme :

Higher and technical Education Maharashtra state has sanctioned 32,800 volunteers strength to Pune University for the year 2004-2005. Which has been distributed in 194 colleges situated in Pune, Ahmednagar and Nashik district.

NSS activities have been divided in two major groups. These are regular activities and special camping programme.

The units in Colleges were allotted as 50, 100,150,200 & 250.

1. Common Programmes :

During the year for creating awareness amongs the volunteers following programmes were undertaken by most of the colleges some programmes are mentioned below.

a) Orientation to Volunteers :-

All most all colleges have taken orientation programme for NSS Volunteers to impart information of NSS and know about badge, logo, motto, setup etc.

b) Hiroshima day, Kranti Abhiyan, Teachers day, Independence day, Blood donation, Nirmalya Sankalan, Andhashraddha Nirmulan were some of the programmes.

2. Special Camp :

Special camps were organised by colleges between 15th November to 10th February 2004 in villages with a theme of 'Youth for Cleanliness.' Dr. Sanjay Chakane, NSS Co-ordinator visited different camps along with State Liaison Officer, Assistant Programme Adviser and District Co-ordinators etc.

The camps were organised for making bunds for water harvesting, water literacy, constricting roads etc.

This year special camp activities were concentrated on particular field normal as continues contour benches (CCT). The trainee was given by Maharashtra Knowledge Co-operation Limited (MKCL). In this trainee volunteers and Programme Officers were thourly trained for counter marking, digging and actual plantation. Training was also imparted for total water literacy, water management, soil management, soil conservation and plantation etc. This programme was taken under consideration after training of programme co-ordinator and district co-ordinator at Hanberwadi Tal. Gargoti Dist. Kolhapur organised by SLO office and TORC Mumbai. The programme officers were trained in different camps the actual planning and action plan was done by programme officers themselves.

1)Pune City :- There are 48 colleges under Pune City most of them have taken their camps at Doundaj, Chambli, Sategoan, Gargotwadi, Radeshwari, Waghoil, Thakurpimpri, Diwe, Pune University campus etc.

- 1) **Pune Rural :-** All programme co-ordinator meeting was taken on 25th Oct. 2004 at Rajgurunagar in Jarewadi. By showing CCT work to all colleges programme co-ordinator, all of them called for them taking special camps alternately in different villages. Thus special camps were taken at Pabal, Pandhare, Jarewadi, Daundaj.
- 2) **Ahmednagar Division :-** All programme co-ordinators meeting was taken on 20th Oct. 2004 at Rajur. In this meeting working related to CCT in different villages is distributed among the colleges. Thus special camps were taken at Mohoj Devade, Chandgaon, Wadule, Pimpalgaon Wagha, Jakhangaon, Pengiri, Gondegaon, Zikri, Bedepur etc.
- 3) **Nashik Division :-** All programme co-ordinator meeting of all colleges in Nashik was taken on 21st Oct. 2004 at Kalwan. According to this, showing work of CCT to all and distributing different villages to each college for camp. In such way, camps were taken at Arihantwadi, Anchai, Godegaon Marur, Bakedare, Buyane, Nilgavhan, Sonagiri, Dehane etc.

1. Total CCT work done by NSS Volunteers:

Out of 194 colleges under University of Pune 171 Colleges have completed their campus specially on continuous counters trenches & volunteers digged 98,542 Meters CCT. The CCT Work is normally 2 feet deep & 1.5 feet wide along the counters.

2. Inter-exchange programme of NSS functionaries:-

16th April to 23rd April 2004 the interexchange programme for NSS functionaries was organised between NSS cell Maharashtra state and Burkarullah University, Bhopal-Madyapradesh. There were 12 NSS functionaries form all over Maharashtra in which Prof. Nilofer Ahmed SLO, Capton Subhash Chand, APA, Dr. Sanjay Chakane Programme coordinator Pune University Pune, few district co-ordinator and few programme officers and few principles of colleges were involved. Objective of the interexchange Programme of thoughts about caluts education, social aspect and to NSS work done by Bhopal University. In the year 2005 – 2006 team of 12 members form Burkat Ullah University come in Pune University.

3. State level training programme for NSS cell personalities:

5 to 6 May 2004 two-day programme for NSS functionaries was organised for NSS personalities who works in NSS cell of respective universities. In this functionary, 52 workers and 8 NSS officers from all over Maharashtra were participated. This functionary opening done by Vice Chancellor and Prof. Kalil Ahmed, Prof. S.S. Jadav, Prof. P.R. Gaikwad, Principal Nandkumar Nikam, Prof. Nilufer Ahmed, Capton Subhash Chand,

Dr. Sanjay Chakane all Guide working method with written group discussion.

4) University level NSS camps:-

30th May to 5th June 2004, the camp arranged for 182 students from different colleges; under Pune University with collaboration of Waghire college at Daundaj Tal- Purandar, Dist- Pune. In this clamp, training was given by Maharashtra Dyan Mandal to all students participated in camp. Like how to use counter marker a digging work guidance given by Mr. Suhas Bandal and Shri Salak. Dr. Budiji Mulik, Prof. M.S. Jadav, Prof. Dilip Kadam, Prof. Tej Nivlikar guidance to all students. At the end of camp, 1000 plants were planted in CCT with Prof. Arun Adsool, Prof. Sambaji Pathare, Management committee member, Pune University, Pune.

5) State level Pune to Pandarpur Vrukshdindi :-

NSS cell Maharashtra Pune University, Pune has jointly organised state level Pune to Pandarpur wrukshdindi and on the auspicious occasion of Shree Sant Dyaneshwar Palkhi. The wrukshdindi was organised from 10th June to 29th June from Pune to Pandarpur. 150 NSS Volunteers from cell over Maharashtra participated in dindi. Dindi was inaugurated with hands of the minister Hon'ble Jaydatt Shirsagar, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Dr. Ashok Kolaskar, Dr. S.N. Pathan, Registrar Dr. D.D. Deshmukh, Prof. Nilufer Ahmed, Captan Subhas Chand, Prof. Tej Nivlikar, Dr. S.D. Chakane.

NSS Volunteers walked more than 250 kms all the way from Pune to Pandarpur along with Palkhi. Volunteers sowed more than 30,000 seeds at Wadkinala and they planted more than 3000 different kinds of plants such as Chinch, Bor, Babul etc. at Doundaj and at different places of Palkhi stay. Volunteers also clean the Road way after moment of Palkhi.

The closing ceremony was organised at Pandarpur in Rayat education Societies College, Pandarpur. For kan dignitaries were present at the time of closing ceremony. Prof. Nilufer Ahmed, Hon,ble Vice Chancellor of Shivaji University Dr. Manikrao Salunke, Prof. Sukhadev Bhole, Captan Subhas Chand, Prof. N.S. Jadav, Dr. Sanjay Chakane etc.

Volunteers were given 50 different kinds of seeds that they can plant all over the Maharashtra.

6) Organisation of camp for drought prone area:-

After the decision of management council and Hon'ble vice Chancellor Dr. Ashok Kolskar University of Pune establish a cell for drought prone area for organising camps. As the drought prone area required literacy about water the cell has decided to organised camp for water literacy, water management etc. training about this water management and contour trenches was given by Maharashtra knowledge corporation limited Pune. The training was given in 6 different colleges to 700 volunteers and more than 100 NSS programme officer. 12 colleges organised camps at different places in drought prone area as shown below.

7) Bijaropan Programme :-

The bijaropan programmed was organised at 6 different places in three districts. For pune city programme organised as Sinhagad fort on 1st August. 4000 volunteers of 49 colleges participated and thrown 4 lake seeds of different varieties which were kept in small mud pots with mud and gobar.

Same programme were organised at Bhuleshwar, Shivneri, and Thapling for pune rural, Mohatadevi, for Ainagar and Vanil (Saptshrungigad) for Nashik.

In all 10000 volunteers taken part in this programme and more than 10 lake seeds were thrown along slope of hills were human being couldn't reach.

8) Two days District level camps:-

3rd and 4th August 2004 District level Camps for CCT training were organised at Doundaj, Rajgurunagar, Rajur and Kalwan for respective Districts. The training was imported by Maharashtra Knowledge Corporation Limited Pune. The camps were organised by District Co-ordinaotar Colleges.

9) 9 August 04 Water literacy Programme (Jal Saksharata Ahbiyan) :-

The student volunteers who were trained on 3rd and 4th August in district camps were the trainers who gave training of CCT in their respective colleges on 9th August 2004. Where more than 30,000 students were trained by Programme Officers and trainers along with CD.

10) AIDS Training Programme :-

AIDS Training Programme was organised by Programme Advisory cell, New Delhi at Jaypur between 21st to 23rd August 2004. From Pune University of Pune Co-ordinator Dr. Sanjay Chakane and Dist. CO-ordinator, Prof. Nitin Ghorpade attended the workshop and they have presented paper on “Work done under N.S.S. for U.T.A.”

District level meeting were organised for yearly planning in all four district. Along with programme officers two students from each college were also attended the meeting.

District wise action plan of Disaster Management of was prepared during this convention.

In order to handle natural / man made calamities, social issue of Disaster Management as the central theme of the convention was inaugurated by auspicious hands of Hon. Minister Ajitdada Pawar, minister of water resource development, Maharashtra State Government. Vice
