COURSES OF STUDIES FOR M.A. IN SOCIOLOGY

Each student admitted to M.A. Course in Sociology Under Utkal University will take a total of 10 courses out of which courses SOC-01 to SOC-07 and SOC-10 (PW) shall be compulsory and he/she will choose two special papers out of twelve Elective / Special courses provided. Students will appear M.A. Part-I Examination in the first set of five courses (SOC-01 to SOC-05) of which unit - V of paper-III (SOC-03) is an application part of the course which is compulsory for the degree. Students will appear M.A. Part-II examination in the second set of five courses. i.e., (Course No. SOC-06, SOC-07 and SOC-10 as compulsory and two elective papers such as SOC-08 from any one Elective Course Group - A and SOC - 09 from any one Elective Course of Group - B).

Each paper carries 100 marks and the total marks for M.A. Examination is 1000 (M.A Part - I-500 marks and M.A. Part - II-500 marks).
