1. Introduction

For the rest of the paper, please use Times New Roman 12 points. This document explains and demonstrates how to prepare your abstract for the "1st National Conference on Energy and Environment (NC2E-2014)", which will be held on February 20-22, 2014 at The University of Pune. The best way to prepare your abstract is to read these instructions and follow the outline of this text. Use paper size A4. Margins: top 25mm; bottom 15 mm; left and right 20 mm. The preferred language of the abstract is English. The length should not exceed two pages. Submitting your abstract to the Symposium committee will be assumed to grant the committee the copyright to use the abstract for the proceedings.

Use *italics* to emphasize a word or phrase. Boldface and capitals should be used for section headings (see the section on section headings).

2. Organization of the Text

2.1 Section headings

The section headings are in boldface capital and lowercase letters. Second level headings (e.g., 2.1, 2.2, ...) start with the first letter capitalized and the rest of the heading in lower case. Sub-sub-headings appear like sub-headings, except that they are in italics and not boldface. (See the sub-sub headings in this section.)

2.1.1 Page numbers

Do not insert page numbers.

2.1.2 Tables

Number tables as Table 1, Table 2, Tables should be centered on the page. The caption text, which should be self-explanatory, may be above or below the table, but this should be consistent throughout the abstract. Units in tables should be given in square brackets [MeV].

2.1.3 Figures

Number figures as Fig. 1, Fig. 2, Figures should be centered on the page. The caption text, which should be self-explanatory, may be above or below the table, but this should be consistent throughout the abstract. If possible, please include your figures as graphic images.

3. Literature References

Please use just the reference *number* in square brackets (e.g., [1]). Two or more references at a time may be put in one set of brackets [3, 4]. The references are to be numbered in the order in which they are cited in the text and are to be listed at the end of the abstract under the heading **References**

(see below). There is no specific format for references. The authors could use whatever format they are familiar with; however, it should be consistent throughout the abstract.

4. Summary

We understand that this may be a busy time for some authors, but we would appreciate it very much if you could send the abstract electrically to <u>ses.event@unipune.ac.in</u> by Jan. 20, 2014.

Please notify the Symposium committee if you have difficulty submitting the abstract by the deadline. For submitting abstract, only MS-Word for Windows should be used. Thank you very much for your cooperation.
