## **PROGRAMME OF DIPLOMA IN LABOUR LAWS AND LABOUR WELFARE EXAMINATION, NOVEMBER, 2011**

1. Candidates are required to be present at respective place of examination fifteen minutes before the time of the first paper and ten minutes before the time of each subsequent paper.
