Programme of Master in Labour Laws and Labour Welfare / ML (Labour Law and Labour Welfare) Examination November, 2012

1. Candidates are required to be present at the respective place of examination fifteen minutes before the time fixed for the first paper and ten minutes before the time of each subsequent paper.
2. Candidates are forbidden from taking any material into the examination hall, that can be used for malpractice at the time of examination.
3. Candidates are requested to see the notice board at their place of examination regularly for changes if any, that may be notified later in the programme.
4. No request for any concession such as change in time or day fixed for the University Examination on religious or any other ground shall be granted.
