

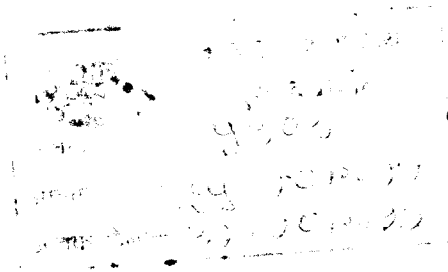

Dear Dr. Sanjay Chahande,

Greetings from the United States – India Educational Foundation (USIEF).

USIEF is a bilateral organization funded by the Governments of India and the US which promotes mutual understanding between the nationals of India and the nationals of the US through the educational exchange of outstanding scholars, professionals and students. Since its inception, USIEF has awarded over 18,000 Fulbright, Fulbright-Nehru, and other prestigious grants and scholarships in almost every academic discipline.

On July 4, 2008, the Government of India and the United States signed a new agreement and henceforth implement the now renamed, Fulbright-Nehru scholarship program as full partners. As part of this program, nearly 150 US scholars and students are likely to visit India in 2013-14. A similar number of Indian scholars and students will be visiting the US during this period.

**I am writing to inform you of the opportunity to host a US Fulbright–Nehru scholar at your campus for a duration ranging from four to six months under the auspices of Fulbright-Nehru Visiting Lecturer Program.**

Under this program, USIEF will arrange for a Lecturer from a US University to teach at your institute for a period of 4-6 months. USIEF will pay for the scholar's international travel and full maintenance during the grant period. Host institutions are asked to provide access to library/computer facilities for the scholar and to provide office space during his/her tenure at your campus.

**Visiting Lecturer awards are open in all disciplines.** Some of the preferred areas for the 2013-14 program are Agricultural Sciences; Economics; Education; Energy, Sustainable Development and Climate Change; Environment; International Relations; Management and Leadership Development; Media and Communications with focus on Public Service Broadcasting; Public Administration; Public Health; Science and Technology; and Study of the United States.
