Applications are invited for one Research Associate (RA) position and three Junior Research Fellow (JRF) positions to work in a research project entitled 'Flux-tower Measurements over a Forest Canopy Representative of Northern Western Ghats to Quantify Forest-Atmosphere Exchange of Carbon Dioxide, Water Vapor and Energy'. funded by Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM), Ministry of Earth Sciences, Govt. of India.

The research work involves intensive micrometeorological field experiments and selected candidates should be willing for frequent experiment site visits and stay in forested areas. The job responsibilities include setup of meteorological instruments on tall towers, data collection, maintenance, data analysis and publication of results.

RA position: 1 (Open).

Qualification: Ph.D. in Atmospheric Sciences or related fields with proven experience in Meteorological measurements and atmospheric data analysis.

Emoluments: Rs.22,000/ month + H.R.A.

JRF Positions: 3 (Open: 1, SC: 1, ST: 1)

Qualification: M. Tech or M. Sc in Atmospheric Sciences/ Meteorology with 55 % marks or equivalent grade (5.5 GPA on a 10 point scale or 3.5 GPA on a 6 point scale). Candidates who have completed their degree and results declared are only eligible to apply.

Emoluments: Rs.16,000/ month + H.R.A for NET qualified candidates.
